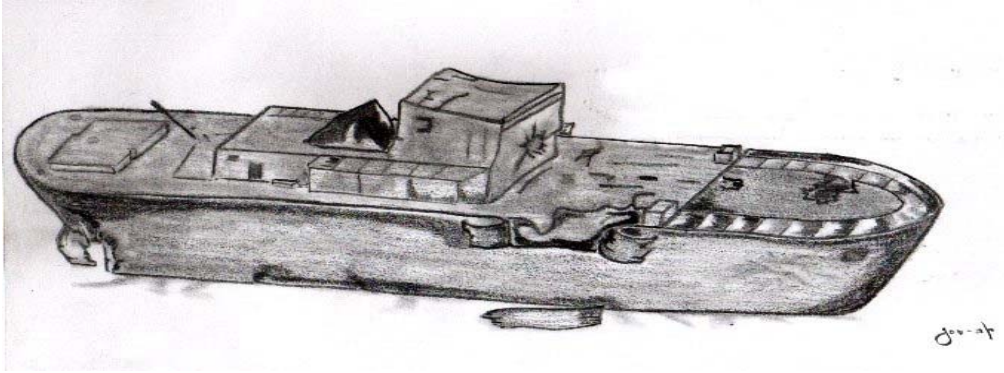


# Patrol Boat

Generally called the Japanese patrol boat this ship has not been fully identified as to name or even type. About 105 feet long and 18 feet wide, An trawler style vessel, Possibly a 150 ton tug boat or a Submarine chaser.

This vessel is situated in Triboa Bay at a depth of 18 - 25 meters (60-75 feet). Sitting upright the wreck is a great dive with average visibility from 7-13 meters (20-40 feet) and plenty of marine life. The compartments provide hiding places for many schools for young fish. Buoy attached at the bow.

## Dive levels

Novice: not recommended due to depth

Basic: the deck level of this boat is at 60 feet allowing a basic diver to explore the top surface of the boat. The pilot deck is at 55 feet, has most of its roof removed making for a safe penetration.

Experienced, Advance: can continue around the hull

Wreck: some penetration is possible
